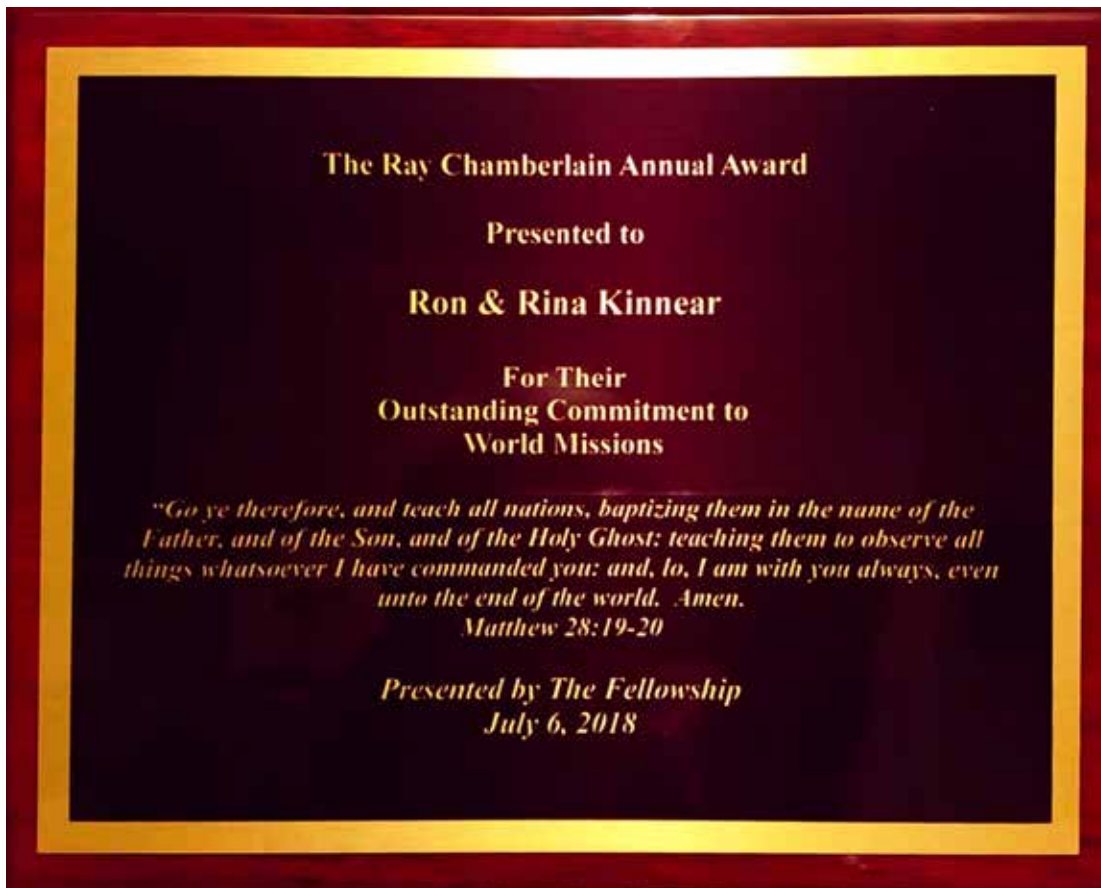
Ron & Rina Kinnear— 2018 Missionaries of the Year!

The president of The Fellowship International Steve Holden prayed for Ron and Rina Kinnear at their bi-annual conference.

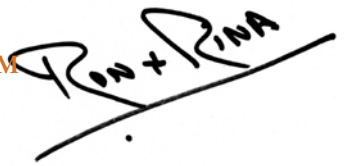
