Our History

The development of the Africa Pentecostal Mission Consultation (APMC) was started in 2015 based on the discussion between the chairmen of Missions Commissions of Pentecostal World Fellowship (PWF) (**Dr. Arto Hämäläinen**) and World Assemblies of God Fellowship (WAGF) (**Rev. Mission Director Brad Walz**).

The mission commissions of both of those organizations were in favor to develop this kind of cooperation because many African Pentecostal churches had started or were planning to start their own mission programs. The idea was discussed also by some East and Central African Pentecostal leaders in 2015, and they felt this kind of collaboration urgent and actual.


The first gathering took place at Nairobi 29 Nov.-4 Dec., 2016. About 260 leaders from 30 countries came together. The future of this kind of cooperation was discussed, and the continuation was unanimously wished.
