Encouraged by **Pastor Ronnie Barnard** who contributed generously, four long years ago, Africa Missions bought land for a house to be the residence for the Principal of the Bible College in Kigali, Rwanda, and a place for our ministry teams to stay when working in the country of Rwanda. The land was purchased and the walls came up. Then, due to finances, the work had to stop. For all these years, we have believed God for the roof to be completed so that the walls would not deteriorate in the rainy seasons.

Finally, at the 30th World Missions Conference **Pastor Virgil & Linda Amundson** of the Shell Lake Full Gospel Church in Shell Lake, Wisconsin, in October, 2016, our roof-dream came true! The theme of this conference was "More Than..." . The Lord proved to be "More Than..." in meeting the need to roof this house. He also is "More Than..." able to help us finish this building project. And...the roof is now ON!

Will You Help Us Finish this House?

Now, we must finish the house. If you notice in the pictures, the windows and doors must quickly be put on to prevent squatters from taking over the house. This is a great emergency. A gift or gifts to the amount of \$4000/R50000 will safeguard the house from squatters.



December of 2013 the foundation was laid and the walls went up, but construction was delayed due to finances. Now the house has a roof!

And we must finish the house for occupancy. This will save Africa Missions much money that is presently spent on accommodations in the city for our team when we go there to do mission work. To complete this building, we need \$30,000. Can you build a house anywhere that has the potential of the one you see in these pictures for that amount? It is almost impossible. Yet, only \$30,000 is standing between us and a very useful house for our resident Principal and our mission teams when they arrive in Kigali, Rwanda. Could you please help us to finish this house. Every dollar/rand of your gift will go directly into this house and in just a short few months, you can rejoice with us that the house of our dreams is finished and in full use!
