### 2009 ended on a very high note and 2010 has begun with a BANG!

*We arrived back from the USA and UK on November 5. This is the schedule that awaited us:*

**November 7:** SOUTH AFRICA—Rina had a very successful Ladies Breakfast. For the first time she broke the 100 barrier as 104 ladies attended. **Lindy MacCauley** was the speaker. Many received the Baptism with the Holy Spirit!

**November 14:** SOUTH AFRICA—**Team Work International Bible College and University** had their graduation. We are affiliated with them and use their curriculum for our students who are mainly refugees from French-Speaking Africa. Our group from **Beam-Africa Bible College** (the name of our Bible College) was the largest to graduate. 46 credentials were received namely, certificates, diplomas and B.A. Theol. Degrees. In fact 18 students had the B.A. Degree conferred upon them! Well done!

**November 21:** ZIMBABWE—Rina and I officially opened a new church in Cranborne, Harare in

**Zimbabwe that seats 1500 people.** This was a great victory as the church was built on a cash basis by the local church believers! One family gave all the bricks. Another paid for the doors and another paid the roof. This is amazing especially if you bring the financial situation of Zimbabwe into consideration.

**November 27:** RWANDA—14 students graduated at our Bible College in Kigali, Rwanda. They were the first to complete the three-year ministerial diploma course. This was our very first graduation. We were blessed to have the **Rev. Ron Bishop** and his wife, **Christi**, as speakers. We also

had two guests from the USA, **Pastor Calvin Hall** and **David Flynn** from South Carolina. We congratulate our principal and his wife **Robert and Susan Owade** for the progress this new college has made.

**December 1-4:** UGANDA—The team moved from Kigali to Kampala, Uganda where Rina and Christi Bishop were the speakers at a very blessed Women's Conference.

**December 7-11:** IBANDA—The team moved to Ibanda which is situated to the West of Uganda where an *Evangelism Explosion* clinic was conducted for pastors. Initially we arranged the clinic for 50 pastors but 84 showed up!

This training is part of our "Something Extra" programme. In three years time (2007 – 2009) we were trusting the Lord for 20,000 first time decisions for Christ. In total 814 pastors and church leaders were trained and thousands of souls have been birthed into

the Kingdom. Exponentially, if the growth continues for the next 8 years 500,000 could be won for the Kingdom of God.

**Herman Hinsbeeck** led this program and we appreciate him for his passion to reach the lost. While Rina and I were in Zimbabwe, Herman conducted clinics for pastors in Rwanda and Burundi.

**January 7:** SOUTH AFRICA—As the **Haakdoornboom Campus** started their academic year on January 15, we had to prepare the campus for the new enrollment of students who mainly come from the country of Zambia. Broken lawnmowers and an unfinished dormitory for married students received attention. **Rina's brother Christo** faithfully worked on the construction with our maintenance man, Frans and good progress is being made.

**January 16-18:** ZIMBABWE BORDER—We went to Musina which is a border town with Zimbabwe. We helped to initiate a feeding scheme for Zimbabweans who were desperate for food and fled their country for greener pastures in South Africa. The UN and **Joyce Meyer** increased the capacity of this program which enable Boettie Visser and his team to feed 2000 people on a daily basis!. Our role changed to providing Christian Literature. We have already supplied tons of materials and during this recent visit we took 150,000 Gospel Tracts to Musina. Each person served with a plate of food also receives a tract. We saw how hundreds were receiving their food with gratitude. After the meal, many were standing around or sitting on rocks reading the Gospel tracts that pointed the way to the Saviour.

**February 13:** SOUTH AFRICA—The running has not stopped. Our inner-city campus enrolled students this week. Rina is also preparing for a Ladies Breakfast on February 13. The guest speaker is **Diane Mullins** from Hamilton, Ohio. I am preparing to receive a young man from Eaton, Ohio who will be coming to help us complete a few building projects on the Haakdoornboom Campus.
